



The **RYA Day Skipper Theory Course** is an entry level shorebased programme that covers basic seamanship together with an introduction to navigation and weather for sail and power craft.

#### Who is this Course for?

There is no requirement for pre-course qualifications; however, the RYA considers some practical sailing experience would be helpful.

#### What the course includes:

- Topics covered include: navigation, pilotage, chartwork, rules of the road, emergency & safety procedures and weather
- 2 assessment papers: Seamanship and Chartwork

#### Course Duration

- Intensive 40 hr course taking 5 days (with a 6<sup>th</sup> in reserve), or
- Course can be spread over a couple of weeks
