



The RYA/MCA Yachtmaster Coastal Certificate of Competence is recognised worldwide and indicates that the holder has the knowledge and skills to skipper a yacht on coastal passages.

### Who is this Course for?

The course is designed to prepare a more experienced skipper for accreditation by the RYA/MCA as Yachtmaster Coastal. The minimum pre-exam experience: 30 days sea time (2 days as skipper), 800 miles (½ the miles must be in tidal waters) and 12 night hours; however if you have a Coastal Skipper Practical Course Completion Certificate these minima are reduced to: 20 days sea time (2 days as skipper), 400 miles and 12 night hours. The candidate also needs VHF license & First Aid Certificate. Minimum age 17 yrs

## What the course includes

Previous completion of the Coastal Skipper/ Yachtmaster Offshore Theory while not essential is highly desirable; your instructor will assume your navigation is to that level with a thorough knowledge of Collision Regulations.

- Advanced yacht handling under sail and power including emergency situations
- 4 hours night sailing (including pilotage at night)
- Other topics covered include: navigation (both offshore and in limited visibility), weather forecasting, passage planning, watch keeping, preparation for sea and handling in heavy weather.

### **Course Duration**

5 days onboard a yacht plus 2 day exam

Successful candidates will be awarded the "RYA/MCA Yachtmaster Coastal Certificate of Competence"
