RYA Coastal Skipper & Yachtmaster Offshore Theory

The **RYA Coastal Skipper & Yachtmaster Offshore Theory Course** is an advanced shorebased programme. Following a major review, the RYA issued a completely re-written / re-styled of this course and assessment papers in early 2017

Who is this Course for?

There is no requirement for any pre-course qualifications; however the RYA suggests that the minimum experience is completion of the Day Skipper Shorebased course.

What the course includes:

- Topics covered include: advanced navigation, tides, tidal streams, position fixing, buoyage, pilotage, lights, rules of the road, meteorology plus passage planning and passage making.
- 3 assessment papers: Chartwork, Collision Regulations, and Passage Making.

Course Duration

- Intensive 6 course, (however the course with the assessment papers can take 7 days)
- or
- Course can be spread over a couple of weeks / long weekends (3 days each weekend)
- There is a requirement for some "homework" outside the confines of the classroom

Upon Completion of the Course

- You will be awarded the Shorebased Course Certificate – RYA/MCA Coastal Skipper & Yachtmaster Offshore
